DEMO: Creating a Title Graphic

1. **Create a subfolder in your Graphics folder called Search Engines.**
2. **Set up the canvas.** File, New, Enter the width of **800** and height of **250** of the canvas in pixels. Select the color of the canvas background (choose any color). Select OK.
3. **Add Text.** Select the Text Tool (A). Click on the Canvas and key the text. **TYPE IN: SEARCH ENGINES**
4. **Select the text object.** Click on the White Point (subselection tool) in the tools panel. Select the text object.
5. In the Properties inspector box at the bottom, change the Font, Font Color, Font Size, Line Color
6. **Add Effect to the Text.** Click on the **+ sign** by Effects in the properties box. Select an effect. (You may need to use the white pointer tool to select the text object)
7. **Trim the Canvas.** Select Modify, Canvas, Fit Canvas
8. **Save as png graphic.** File, Save, name the graphic, be sure to leave it as a png graphic type. You can edit png graphics—not jpeg or gif graphics **SAVE AS B232 Web Page**

9. **File/Export**. You must export the graphic as a gif graphic type and save in your image folder. You will use the gif graphic in your website. The png graphic is used if you need to edit the graphic. When editing the graphic, save the png and also remember to export the graphic as a gif and replace the original. (Use gif for images with fewer colors and jpeg used for images requiring many colors such as pictures) GO TO FILE/EXPORT. **EXPORT TO: B232 Web Page Design/Graphics/Search Engines/title.gif.**

****Important:** No spaces in the file name when you save. You can use the underscore to separate words.
